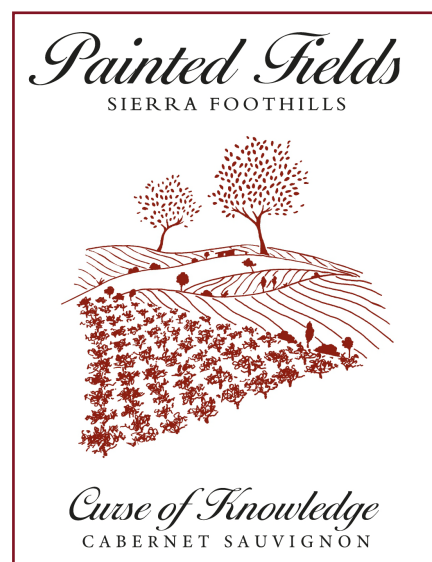


CURSE of KNOWLEDGE CABERNET SAUVIGNON
